#### **FISHING FORECAST FOR 2008**

**Spring:** Dabs should carry on till March, last year we had a run of Plaice around April with school Bass showing in May.

**Summer:** Bass should be around in good numbers and if get decent weather loads of Mackerel Garfish and Scad. The odd Smoothhound could show as well, maybe a Turbot or two chasing the fry.

**Autumn:** Sole have been a bit thin on the ground over the last couple of years but lets hope this year could be better. This year quite a few Red Gurnard were reported. Bigger Whiting should show but in the last few years we have had them all year round. Bass can only get better with bigger fish year on year.

**Winter:** Codling from late autumn on peaking before Christmas but as this year shows we are still catching Codling right through January! After Christmas Sprat Dabs overla 1lb could be caught! Dogfish can show at anytime but picking up speed in the winter. Other species available in their season Pouting, Rockling and Eels.

#### **MATCHES FOR 2008**

Sad to say the turn out for the Matches in 2007 were poor. Steve would like to run more Club Matches but it is down to you! If you would like to fish Club Matches let Steve know.
