
DO I'T FORGET TO RENEWED FOR 2011

Some memories from a long time member Bob Fowler

My autumn and winter fishing continues to be focused on cod and over the years, (I've fished the area since the early 1970s) I've caught many good fish up to 18lbs, with many smaller doubles also included in my catches. I've lost bigger fish, one real monster spat out a near 2lb hooked whiting when within sight and within just a few yards of the beach, so have experienced some extreme disappointment as well. Best catch in terms of quality of fish was 3 double figure fish of 121/2, 13 and 14lbs all within 30 minutes one bright, calm and sunny December morning. Unfortunately, this was in the late 1970s, so is really just a hazy memory now. I have had some fair catches in recent years, but whilst these were high in numbers, were down on size, eg, generally in the 2-3lb range with a small number between 4 - 7lb; the best again taken in daylight in November 2008 and weighing in at just over 13lbs. I did manage to fluke a 31/4 lb sole in the early autumn of 2008 in broad daylight in front of the power station, but this was a real surprise. Last season was a poor one for me, as I could only manage five outings, and each time it seemed either the sea was full of weed to the point of being virtually unfishable or I just didn't catch, despite conditions being favourable. From memory, I only managed one cod of 7lbs. My son Steve, (also a member of DAA) had several good catches, but unfortunately I was unable to accompany him on the occasions that he was successful. In addition to the many dozens of cod caught by me over the years, I've also caught a reasonable number of autumn and early winter bass, up to 7lbs in weight, but the double still eludes me, despite my 40 odd years of dedicated shore fishing predominantly along the Kent and Sussex coast.
